Please can you help your child to cut them out using scissors.

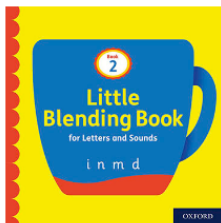
Hold up the flashcards for your child to say the matching sound. Use pure sounds. This means saying "p" (a plosion of air from your mouth with no voice), not "puh."

On the back of each flashcard, you will find a mnemonic that will help your child learn how to form the letter. Help them practice writing in the air with their finger as you say the mnemonic together.

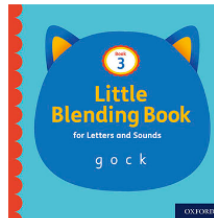
