English

In English this week, Year 4 have planned and begun to write their persuasive letters. The purpose of the letters is to persuade the witch from our vehicle text, 'The Lost Happy Endings', to return the happy endings that she stole from children's stories. In our Sentence Work, we consolidated our understanding of possessive apostrophes, expanded noun phrases and fronted adverbials.
