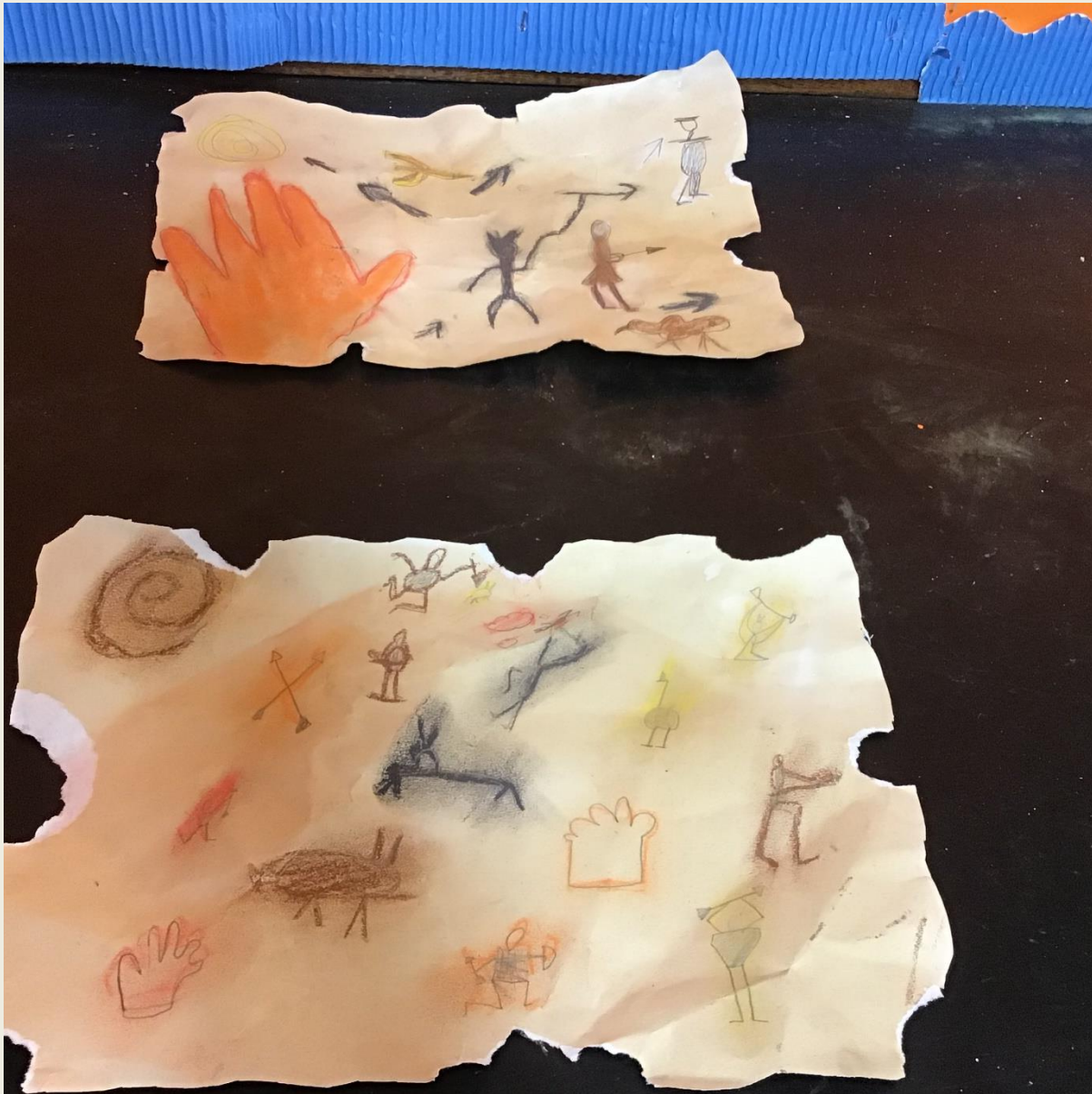
A bar chart showing how much of each food group I ate over two days



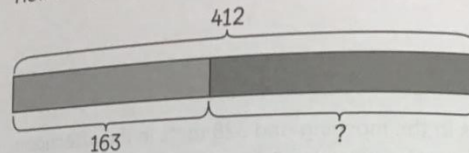

Everything was different now with all the pain and I was feeling it.

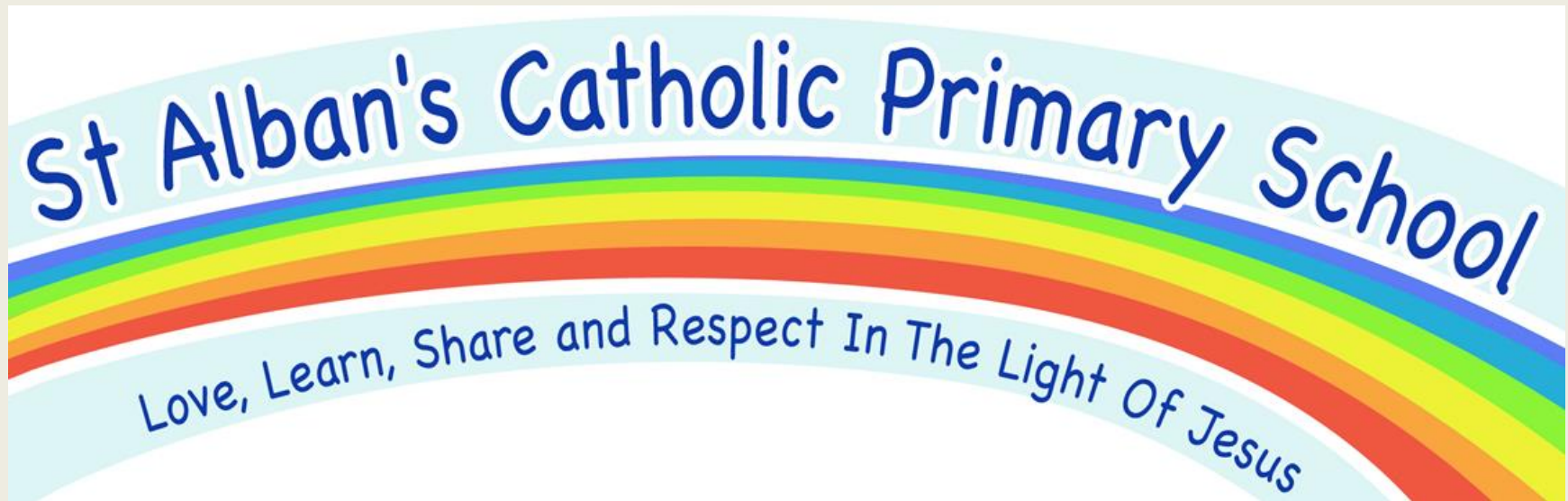
