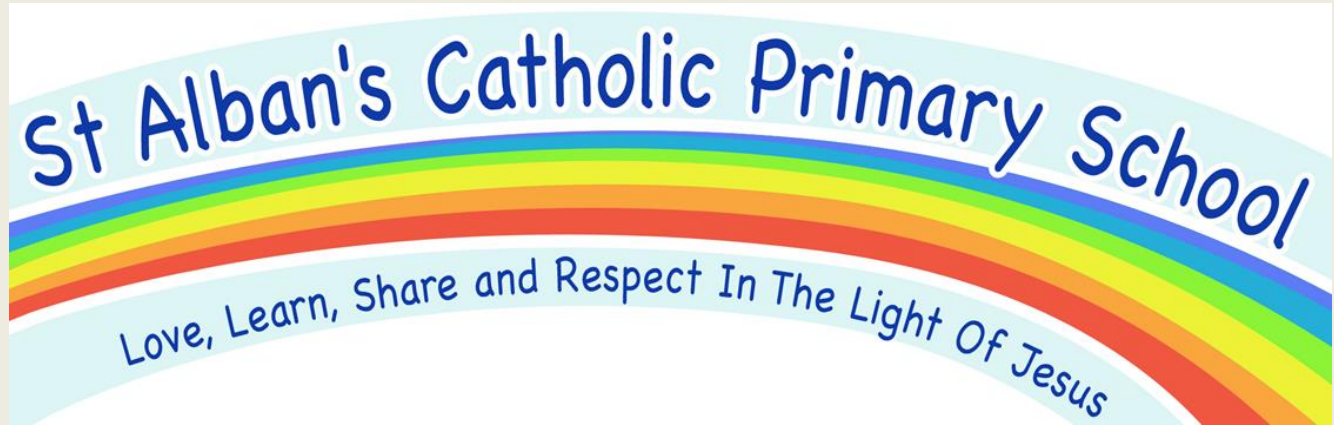


Year 5
